#### NOTES FOR THE CONSULTATION OF THE EXAM CALENDAR 5-y DEGREE PROGRAM [LAW]

The **exam timetable** is organized in periods that do not coincide with the lessons. Each exam period consists of one or more sessions. The exam timetable allocates 4 exam sessions; 2 of them are scheduled after the teaching semester, the third and fourth sessions are considered as supplementary exam sessions. For language courses 5 exam sessions are scheduled.

Lessons are suspended at mid-semester in both the first and second semester for 1st partial exams. 2nd partial exams are held at the end of the semester. Partial exam dates may or may not coincide with those fixed for general exams.

Students can take exams in all sessions as long as they satisfy the attendance requirements (semester course lessons in the study plan must be finished). For some types of exams and for some courses, there can be some exam access limitations.

The exam periods and exam sessions (reference period: October 2025 - September 2026) are scheduled as follows.

# (\*) In the period 9 – 20 December 2025 an exam session, open to all enrolled students is scheduled for 1/2 compulsory courses per program/year of studies replacing the January – first period- 2026 exam session which, as a consequence, will not be scheduled.

(\*\*) For the compulsory and compulsory courses chosen by the students the second partial exam if written is generally scheduled in both sessions of the exam periods scheduled at the end of the teaching period. For elective courses, however, the second partial exam may be scheduled during both sessions of the exam periods scheduled at the end of the teaching period, only at the

discretion of the course director.

As a consequence, for the course typologies above, a second partial exam is scheduled:

- with reference to the first semester, in the period 21 January to 3 February 2026 as an alternative to the one scheduled in the period 8 to 20 January 2026 (or to the one scheduled for the period 09 20 December 2025 if it is a call open to all students);
- with reference to the second semester, a second partial exam is scheduled in the period 15 June to 10 July 2026 as an alternative to the one scheduled in the period 21 May to 13 June 2026.

## There are rules and limitations to access the second partial exam, for all details check paragraph Exam and partial exam registration procedure in the Guide to the University.

#### Note

- "session" refers to both the exams of the current academic year and the previous years;
- the fourth exam session for II semester courses will be held in January second period -2027;
- exam sessions for the I semester foreign language courses are scheduled for: December, January (first/second period), March, May/June and August/September; exam sessions for II semester foreign language courses are scheduled for: October, January (second period), June, July and August/September;
- if students choose a course relating to the 2-y Degree Programs as an elective course, they must follow the exam calendar of such Degree Program.

A **reserved exam session** has been scheduled in December **(09 – 20 December 2025)**, for 1<sup>st</sup> semester courses, open only to students who:

- 1. are participating in: Exchange, Themis and Free Mover programs abroad in the 2nd semester 2025/2026 academic year;
- 2. are Incoming 1st semester (Exchange, Themis and single courses for visiting students);
- 3. are participating in curricular internships (including additional internships) abroad or in Italy in January/February 2026 period;
- 4. are participating in the Moot Program (as participants or as a coach).

Please note that for the additional exam session students **CANNOT** sit exams for **previous year's courses which have not been passed**, only those students whose teaching activities described in points 1, 3 and 4 will start before the end of the January- second exam period (3 February 2026) are admitted to participate in such session.

If the second semester courses exam session foreseen between 21/05/26 and 13/06/26 is scheduled for later than 31 May 2026, an extraordinary exam session will be called before 31 May 2026 reserved to incoming students only.

There is NO overlapping between compulsory course exam sessions of the same year and same semester; therefore, no two exams on the same day are usually scheduled except for December, January– second period – (21 January to 3 February 2026), March and August/September exam periods as the available exam days are limited. Such overlapping rule refers only to compulsory courses of the year in which the student is enrolled and do not refer to previous years' exams which have not been passed yet and/or to elective courses.

#### **Exam timetable**

The exam timetable for the October 2025 - September 2026 period is published not later than the end of July on the University Internet site at <u>www.unibocconi.eu/examtimetable</u>. During the year the timetable of an exam session may be changed (only to a later date or time), in which case students do not need to re-register for the exam since their registration is automatically transferred to the new timetable. Exam dates are updated daily on the Internet site. In addition, any changes to the exam timetable can be viewed on the yoU@B student Diary. The different types of exams are identified in the exam timetable by the following letters:

- PI Partial exam
- **S** General written exam
- O General oral exam

In addition, regarding the exam session held during 9-20 December 2025 reserved to specific categories of students:

- IS Partial exam
- SS General written exam
- **OS** General oral exam
