

NOTES FOR THE CONSULTATION OF THE EXAM CALENDAR
2-y DEGREE PROGRAMS IN TRASFORMATIVE SUSTAINABILITY E CYBER RISK STRATEGY and
GOVERNANCE

A.Y. 2026/2027

The exam timetable is scheduled in periods (including 1 or more sessions) that do not coincide with the periods when lectures are held. All courses have 3 exam sessions.

Exam distribution includes 2 sessions held at the end of the teaching semester; the third session (the last one) is considered a supplementary session.

Lectures are suspended at mid-semester in the first semester for 1st partial exams. 2nd partial exams are held at the end of the semester of lessons. The dates of partial exams may or may not coincide with the dates fixed for general exams. Students can take exams in all sessions once the semester lectures included in their study plan have finished. For some types of exams and for some courses, there may be some limitations to access the exams.

For details on exam dates (exam timetable) for PoliMi courses, see the 'PoliMi' widget available in the yoU@B diary.

(*) For the compulsory courses, the second partial exam, if written, is generally scheduled in both sessions of the exam periods at the end of the exam periods.

Therefore, for the course typologies above, a second partial exam is generally scheduled:

- **with reference to the first semester**, a second partial exam is generally scheduled in the period 20 January - 2 February 2027 as an alternative to the partial exams' session of the period 7 - 19 January 2027 (or the one scheduled in the period 9 - 22 December 2026 if it is a session open to all students).

(*) During the period 9-22 December 2026, for courses held in the first semester, an exam session in January-February 2027 will be scheduled reserved to students participating in an internship in Italy or abroad.

(**) For the compulsory courses and compulsory courses to be chosen by the students, curriculum compulsory courses and for the elective courses included in A, B, C groups of the ESS MSc program, the second partial exam, if written, is generally scheduled in both sessions of the exam periods at the end of the exam periods. For other elective courses, however, the second partial exam may be scheduled during both sessions of the exam periods scheduled at the end of the teaching period, only at the discretion of the course director. As a consequence, for the course typologies above, a second partial exam is generally scheduled:

- **with reference to the 1st semester**, in the period 20 January-2 February 2027 **as an alternative to** the partial exams session of the period 7-19 January 2027.
- **with reference to the 2nd semester**, in the period 3-23 June 2027 **as an alternative to** the partial exams session of the period 17 May-01 June 2027.

NOTES ON CONSULTING THE EXAM CALENDAR

- "Session" refers to both exams of the current year and the previous years;
- the sessions for Languages will be held in: December, January (first/second period), March, June, August/September.

There is NO overlapping between compulsory course exam sessions of the same year of studies and Master of Science degree program; therefore no two exams are usually scheduled on the same day.

The exam timetable for the October 2026 - September 2027 period is published by the end of July on the University website at www.unibocconi.eu/exams.

The timetable of an exam session may be changed during the year (only to a later date or time). In that case, students do not need to re-register for the exam since their registration is automatically transferred to the new timetable.

Exam dates are updated daily on the website. In addition, any changes to the exam timetable can be viewed on the yoU@B student Diary.

Please note that exam start times and the length of the exam (when available) should be considered purely indicative. Exam start and end times may vary depending on the type of exam, the presence of more than one group, possible postponements, etc. Students should therefore follow the instructions related to the day, time and classroom that are usually communicated on the afternoon of the business day before the date of the exam in yoU@B > Exams - Breakdown of the students in the classroom.

The different types of exams are identified in the exam timetable by the following letters:

- **IP** Partial exam (*)
- **S** General written exam
- **O** General oral exam

In addition, regarding the exam session held during 9-22 December 2026 reserved to specific categories of students:

- **IS** Partial exam
- **SS** General written exam
- **OS** General oral exam

(*) The abbreviation **IP** Partial exam refers to all partial exams included in the course, regardless of their placement in the exam timetable (e.g. generally, first partial exam held in mid-semester, second partial exam held at the end of the teaching semester).

CYBER RISK STRATEGY AND GOVERNANCE

The exam timetable is scheduled in periods (including 1 or more sessions) that do not coincide with the periods when lectures are held.

All courses have 3 exam sessions. Exam distribution includes 2 sessions held at the end of the teaching semester; the third session (the last one) is considered a supplementary session.

Lectures are suspended at mid-semester in both the first and second semester for 1st partial exams. 2nd partial exams are held at the end of the semester of lessons. The dates



of partial exams may or may not coincide with the dates fixed for general exams. Students can take exams in all sessions once the semester lectures included in their study plan have finished. For some types of exams and for some courses, there may be some limitations to access the exams.
